May 1 OKC to Memphis, TN

As is usually the case, the first day is designed as a travel day, allowing time to get settled in and get acquainted with new friends, Tour Director, and driver.

May 2 Memphis to LaGrange, GA

AM Visit **Elvis's Birthplace and Museum** in Tupelo, Ms.

May 3 LaGrange to Columbus, GA

AM **Hills and Dales Estate**

Hills and Dales Estate is the home built for textile magnate Fuller E. Callaway and his wife Ida Cason Callaway completed in 1916 in Lagrange, Georgia. The property includes the pre-Civil War Ferrell Gardens started by Nancy Ferrell in 1832 and expanded by her daughter Sarah Coleman Ferrell beginning in 1841. What a beautiful way to start our day.

Lunch -On own before departing for Columbus.

Afternoon AM **National Infantry Museum.**

The National Infantry Museum and Soldier Center salutes soldiers in a 190,000-square-foot facility nestled where Columbus meets Fort Benning. It is the only museum in the country dedicated to the American Infantryman and preserves one of the greatest collections of military artifacts.

As visitors, we will meet the infantryman face to face and join him on his journey. We will come to understand why a soldier puts himself in harm's way, and we will leave transformed, just as the infantry transforms a man into a U.S. soldier.

May 4 Presidential Pathways

AM **Little White House** The **Little White House** was the personal retreat of Franklin D. Roosevelt, the 32nd President of the United States, located in the Historic District of Warm Springs.

Lunch in Warm Springs at the **Bulloch House** - *No question we are in the south when we partake of the meal prepared here.* **YUM**

Can't visit Warm Springs without some shopping time. Enjoy Afternoon continue to Plains, GA, our second presidential stop. Visit **Jimmy Carter National Historic Site and Boyhood Farm.**

May 5 Columbus to Charlotte, NC

Afternoon - **Billy Graham Library**

The Billy Graham Library is a public museum and library documenting the life and ministry of Christian evangelist Billy Graham. The 40,000-square-foot complex is located on the grounds of the international headquarters of the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association.

May 6 Charlotte to Alexandria, VA

May 8 Washington DC


Another entire day in our capital city.
