April 29 Irving to Subiaco, AR D

7:00 Depart Irving

Discover the Swiss winemaking heritage of Wiederkehr Wine Cellars. The oldest and largest winery in mid-America, Wiederkehr Wine Cellars is located on the southern slopes of the Ozark Mountains. Here atop St. Mary's Mountain is where the Wiederkehr family carries on a tradition begun in 1880.

Following lunch, depart for **Subiaco Monastery**, a 40 minute drive via Mt. Magazine scenic byway.

Dinner and overnight at the Monastery.

April 30 Subiaco to Hanceville, AL CB, D

An early morning departure allows time for a visit to St. Jude's Visitors Center in Memphis, visit Ave Marie Grotto in Cullman, AL and arrive in Hanceville for the overnight.

AM – Tour of **St Jude's Children's Hospital.** *From a promise of "Help me find my way in life, and I will build you a shrine" to the fulfillment of his dream, Danny Thomas lived to see his little hospital become an international beacon of hope for the catastrophically ill children of the world.*

Following the tour and a quick lunch on our own, we will travel to Cullman, AL for a tour of **Ave Maria Grotto.** *Known throughout the world as "Jerusalem in Miniature, this attraction is a beautifully landscaped, four-acre park designed to provide a natural setting for the 125 miniature reproductions of some of the most famous historic buildings and shrines of the world. The masterpieces of stone and concrete are the lifetime work of Brother Joseph Zoettl, a Benedictine monk of St. Bernard Abbey.*
