Oct. 12 OKC to Clarksville, TN

An early morning departure allows time to join our Missouri friends in Memphis late afternoon.

Early evening arrive in Clarksville for our overnight.

Have a restful evening as we anticipate our Leaves and Locomotives adventure.

Oct. 13 Clarksville to Huntington, WV CB,D

Getting acquainted with our new friends, we begin our journey, full of excitement as we make our trip through Tennessee and into Kentucky.

On arrival our first stop will be the **Heritage Farm and Museum**, a more than 25,000 square foot farm filled with Appalachian artifacts Within seven museums.

Approaching dinnertime, hope you're hungry.....dinner is served here along with evening entertainment.

Oct. 14 Clarksville to Canaan Valley, WV CB,L

As we continue to make our way through West Virginia, our next stop will be the **New Tygart Flyer**. *This diesel- powered train will take you on a 48-mile wilderness adventure of Appalachian foliage.*

A special buffet will be provided for lunch as we travel and gaze at the wonder of the landscape. The old-fashioned train reaches its pinnacle at **the High Falls of Cheat**, an 18 feet high and 150 feet wide waterfall. There isn't a better way to end a train ride than that!

After spending the day on the train we check into our hotel in the breathtaking Canaan Valley.

Oct. 15 Huntington to Gettysburg, PA**CB,D**

Today we make our way to **Gettysburg**, but before we get there, we make a stop at the **Western Maryland Scenic Railroad** in Cumberland. *This train ride is their classic trip from Cumberland to Frostburg.* After this pleasant ride, we embark on our journey again, stopping to have dinner at the **Dobbin House Tavern in Gettysburg**. *The tavern is said to be the oldest, most historic home in town.*

The dinner is candle-lit, the food is plentiful, and service is spot on. All of these elements give us a glimpse of what life was like over 200 years ago.

Following dinner, return to hotel and call it a day.

Oct. 16 Gettysburg to Lehigh, PA**CB,L**

Our day begins with a guided tour of the **Battlefield of Gettysburg**, recapturing the history of the bloodiest battle on US soil.

Once this sobering tour is over we make our way to Hershey, PA and **Hershey's Chocolate World**. After exploring (and sampling) at Chocolate World we make our way to Jim Thorpe, the epicenter of Pocono foliage. Our home for the next three nights.

Oct. 17 Lehigh**CB,L**

This morning we have planned a number of picture stops as we make our way to ride the **Stourbridge Railroad Co. Pocono Express**. *Here we enjoy 25 miles of history and scenery as we travel along the Lackawaxen River Valley. This railroad is considered the birthplace of the American railroad, because this is where the first train made it's first trial run nearly 200 years ago.* **Unforgettable memories!!!**

Oct. 18 Lehigh**CB**

Lehigh Gorge Scenic Railroad is the ride of the day. *This brief train ride will give us yet another chance to see the wonders of the nature in the state of Pennsylvania.* After the ride, we will have a little free time in Jim Thorpe for lunch on our own and some shopping.

Our next stop is the **Number 9 Coal Mine and Museum**. Our guided tour takes us around the oldest, continually operated, coal mine in the world.

Return to hotel for a free evening.

Oct. 19 New Philadelphia, OH**CB**

It is time to start our journey home. New Philadelphia is today's destination, but before getting there, we make a stop at the **President McKinley Library and Museum**, dedicated to our 25th President.
