### March 2 OKC to Fairbanks, AK

Tour departs from the OKC airport.

### March 3 Fairbanks

AM - **Fairbanks city tour** to include stopping at the 800-mile engineering miracle known as the **Trans-Alaska pipeline** which carries crude oil from Prudhoe Bay to Valdez. Later visit the **Museum of the North** which features cultural and natural history exhibits from the entire state. *Highlights of the galleries include the state's largest gold display, the story of the pipeline, and a special section on the Northern Lights.*

Afternoon and evening - Partake of two classic Alaskan activities: **Ice fishing** and **aurora borealis** viewing. We will be transported to a lake near Fairbanks where tents are set up complete with chairs where we can sit, sip hot cocoa, and enjoy the beautiful aurora borealis while waiting for a bite on the line. Our hosts will show us how to cook up our catch after which we will be free to enjoy it for dinner. **B,D**

## March 4 Fairbanks

Breakfast at hotel

Today journey 60 miles to **Chena Hot Springs**. We will visit the largest year-round ice museum, created from over 1,000 tons of ice and snow. The **Aurora Ice Museum** gallery features amazing ice sculptures created by 16 world champion ice carver, Steve Brice And his wife, Heather, a seven- time world champion. Next, we gear up for our guided snow machine tour on the wintery trails that surround the Chena Hot Springs. Be on the lookout for wildlife; moose are often spotted near these trails. We will also have an opportunity to soak in the natural mineral water of the Hot Springs or take a dip in the indoor swimming pool before returning to Fairbanks. B,D



## March 5 Fairbanks

Breakfast at hotel

AM -Visit **Ice Alaska** (*World competition of Ice Art*)

Remainder of the day at leisure.

**OPTIONAL = Arctic Circle Aurora Fly and Drive Tour - \$499.00 per person.**

In the early afternoon depart from Fairbanks by small plane and land across the Arctic Circle in ceremonious fashion and receive an official Arctic Circle certificate. Take a walk ok the arctic tundra, which will give you a sense of the vast scale of Alaska' s arctic regions. Return to Fairbanks with a ground tour on the rugged Dalton Highway. Once the sky gets dark, make stops to scan the northern sky for the aurora borealis.



## March 6 Fairbanks

Breakfast included at hotel.

AM Running **Reindeer Ranch** The local reindeer take us through a guided nature walk in the boreal forest. There we will learn about the natural history of the forest as well as the reindeer themselves. Enjoy the frolicking and leaping reindeer as they run free through the wood.

Evening – **Dinner / Dog Sled Tour**

We will be picked up at the hotel to begin our night of **Dog Sledding and Aurora Borealis** viewing. Arrive at the kennels where the huskies will be ready and waiting for you to bundle up and climb into the sled. The experience of starlight and moonlight reflecting off the snow while gliding down the silent trail is magical. Most of the ride is in open area, so should the Aurora start early we will have a thrilling view of the sky from the dogsled. Back at a cabin, our home cooked dinner will be served while we wait for the Northern Lights to put on their show. Once the Aurora is out, we can enjoy it right from inside the cabin or our spacious outdoor viewing area. **B,D**
